Information for attendees

The workshop will take place at the **National Waterfront Museum** at the marina in the centre of Swansea. The museum is located on Oystermouth Road within easy reach of the train and bus stations, and with plenty of parking nearby. More information about travelling to the museum is available [here](#). We will begin with coffee at 10.30am, with the first session starting at 11am. The workshop will finish at 5pm, with drinks and dinner after for those available in the evening.

Travelling to Swansea

Regular trains from London Paddington, South Wales, and the rest of the UK arrive at Swansea Station on the High Street. The station is a 15 minute walk from the Waterfront Museum.

You can travel by road via the M4 motorway. Exit at Junction 42 for the A483 (signposted Swansea and National Waterfront Museum).

Cardiff Airport is around an hour away by road. [Rail connections](#) are available via Rhose, which has a rail link connecting to Cardiff Central and Bridgend, with onward connections to Swansea.

Bristol Airport also offers connections to the rest of the UK. From here you can travel to Swansea by train, via the airport bus to Bristol Temple Meads, or by bus with National Express.

Accommodation

There are various hotels for different budgets, all within 5-10 minutes' walk of the Museum and in easy reach of the train station. Options include: Premier Inn Swansea City Centre, Travelodge Swansea Central, Dolphin SA1 Hotel, Marriott Hotel Swansea Marina, Dragon Hotel, Morgan's Hotel.
